New members must be voted in by the Board. People interested in membership may contact a Board member to find out what being a member entails. The Board will actively seek people to become members whose natural gifts and skills match the needs of the Board in order to achieve the purpose and objectives of the school. Members must pass a background check.

In accordance with St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church By-Laws, the school board may not be made up of more than 12 members, and a ratio of at least 2 to 1 shall be kept, two being from the congregation and one from the Parent Action Committee, if applicable.

Members can include St. Johns Evangelical Lutheran Church's pastor, volunteers, school parents, congregation members, community members, and employees. Members can join at any time, with no prior involvement with the school. A motion must be passed to accept each new member. Regularly staffed employees of Little Angel Preschool have a voice, but no vote.
